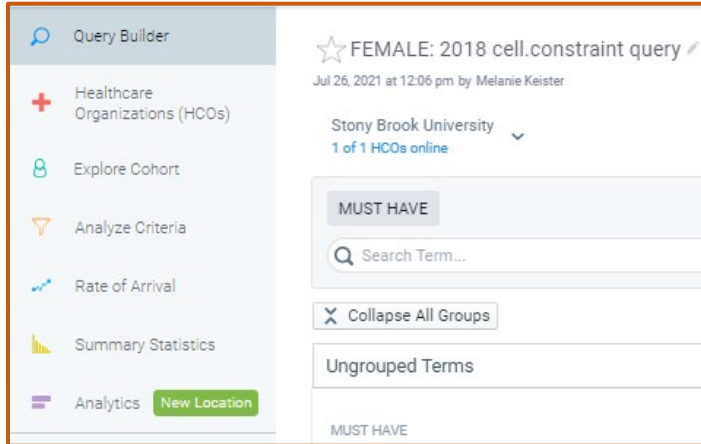


A cohort is the group of patients you have defined using your query. Your study will have as many cohorts as you have queries.

## BASIC EXPLORATION OF ONE COHORT



To browse one of your cohorts, you will select one of your queries so that it is present in the Query Builder screen.

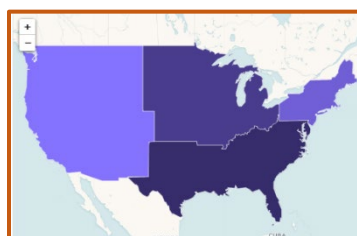
**Explore Cohort** will display the demographics and the prevalence of certain diagnoses, procedures, medications, and labs for the patients in that cohort.

**Analyze Criteria** allows you to assess the viability of your inclusion/exclusion criteria. Select first your most important parameter(s), such as Heart Failure, and then select the remaining parameters to see the result. Each level of this funnel represents one criterion's impact on your patient population.



**Rate of Arrival** predicts the number of patients that will fit your criteria in the coming year, and provides a monthly average based on historical data.

**Summary Statistics** displays basic fact counts of your cohort, and fact distribution geographically if you are using a larger research network.
